REFERENCES AND GENERAL NOTES

The references in parentheses are to the nominal position in the relevant chapters.

22.28a. Perhaps a coin related to the Year 20 mint. The mint mark is completely garbled but X/X and X/X can be made out on either side of the denominational mark M. Goodwin (private correspondence) includes the coin in a non-regular group exhibiting die-link chains and strong stylistic similarities. Struck on a spread flan that may be a hammered down coin although nothing of an undertype is legible.
